As hurricane season is upon us, we would like to remind all tenants of the following section from our Building Manual:

All Tenants must be aware that One Canal Place is **NOT** designed for nor is it intended to be a safe haven for tenants or their employees during a hurricane or similar natural disaster. No food or water is stockpiled, and the building's emergency systems are **NOT** designed to support tenants or their employees during such events. It is likely that, during a hurricane or similar disaster, the building would lose both electricity and water pressure creating unsatisfactory comfort and/or sanitary conditions. For these reasons, access to the building may be denied during such events. Even if access is not denied, any tenant remaining in the building during such events does so at his own risk.
